The following issues must be addressed by the property owner **before we can proceed with this project:**

1. The property owner must have all asphalt roofing, linoleum, tar paper, and like material removed. State Air Pollution Regulations require that this material be removed before we can burn.
2. The property owner must provide the following written documentation:
 - a. Proof of ownership of the property, indicating a clear title to the property with no liens.
 - b. Proof that all insurance on the property has been canceled.
3. The property owner will be responsible for the coordination between all of the utility companies involved, that may have overhead lines or underground lines that may be affected by this project. It is recommended that a letter from the Utility Companies involved be provided to this Office as documented support that the Utility Companies have been made aware of the project and that they have taken any and all steps to protect their lines. The property owner will be responsible for any charges levied by the Utility Company(ies) for relocation of any lines necessary to prevent damage from this project.
4. Due to the location of this property, the property owner shall be responsible for making contact with adjoining property owners to secure access to their property for the sole purpose of conducting live fire drills involved with this property.
5. In order for us to utilize this property to the fullest for a training exercise, all windows and doors should be left intact.

The Fire-Rescue Training Division and Emergency Services Agencies involved with this training program agree to this project, provided all of the conditions that have been outlined have been met. It is further understood that:

1. The County of Augusta and all other agencies involved will assume all responsibility for the personnel and equipment used in this Training Program.
2. The Fire-Rescue Training Division of the County of Augusta and all other agencies involved agree to make every attempt to totally destroy the structure in question by fire, to the extent possible. In the event that the fire involved with this project produces smoke, fire by-products, offensive odors, and/or causes situations that are deemed to be a threat to personal health, safety and/or welfare of the residents/businesses in the area and/or to the motoring public, the fire will be extinguished.
3. The property owner acknowledges that the final cleanup of all debris from this project is the sole responsibility of the property owner. The agencies involved will make every attempt to destroy as much of the structure as possible, thus reducing the amount of clean-up that will be required.
4. The property owner must acknowledge and agree to be responsible for any and all property damage that is a direct result of this project.
