AUGUSTA COUNTY CHALLENGES

- 967 Square Miles w/ Population ~75,000
- 43% of Parcels in Augusta are 2+ Acres (Very Low Density)
- Rolling Hills make Wireless Challenging
- Low Housing Density Increases Network Build Costs
- Making ROI Less Competitive for Private Investment




GRANT COMPETITION CHALLENGES

- Provider Coverage Data
 - Self Reported
 - Coarse Grained for Low Density by Census Block
 - Inaccurate Coverage is Often Over Reported
- Provider Competition
- Procurement Requirements and Scoring
 - Non-Coverage Verification is Labor Intensive
 - Low Density puts us at a significant Disadvantage

Survey Highlights:



- Majority of end-users using:
 - Cable Modem (co-axial or fiber) 22.5%
 - Cellular service or mobile card 20.0%
 - o DSL 19.0%
 - Wireless (from service provider, not home network) 16.2%
 - Satellite or Microwave (dish) 11.3%
- When Rating Current Speed of Connection:
 - o 46.3% Somewhat or Very Dissatisfied
- The major reasons for Internet dissatisfaction:
 - o Bandwidth 62.1%
 - o Price too high 52.2%.
 - Unreliable service 31.7%






Overall Satisfaction:




How would you describe your overall satisfaction with your current Internet service?
