Does your water come from a well, spring, or cistern?

Do you want to learn more about the quality of your water?

How it works:

- 1. At a brief informational meeting, pick up a sample kit and get instructions to collect your household water sample.
- 2. Collect a sample from your tap at home and complete a short questionnaire.
- 3. Drop off sample at the Extension office on Wednesday, June 23 between 7-10 am
- 4. On August 4, come back to interpretation meeting at 7 pm to get your confidential test results, an explanation of what the numbers mean, and information on how to handle any problems that are present.

Cost: \$60 (includes sample analysis cost to test for selected chemical and bacteriological constituents – includes E. Coli, total Coliform bacteria, lead, nitrate, copper, iron, fluoride, sulfate, sodium, total dissolved solids, hardness, arsenic, pH, and manganese). Cash or check accepted at kick-off meetings. Returned check fee is \$50. Payment is due by June 16.
