

Special Use Permits-The Board held fifty-one (51) Public Hearings on these requests. Forty-two (42) were approved, two (2) were denied, two (2) tabled, three (3) were withdrawn, and two (2) on hold.

Extensions of Time-The Board issued four (4) extensions of time.

<u>Cancelled Permits</u> – The Board cancelled one (1) Special Use Permit.





KENNELS

Kennels-The Board had five (5) requests to operate a kennel and all of them were approved.

One (1) request was to continue the operation of the kennel and enclose the existing exercise area. On one (1) request the applicant was to reduce the number of dogs within a year. One (1) permit was approved with the condition that dogs may not be replaced when they expire.

Special operating conditions were placed on each kennel.
