11-01	<u>BARKING DOGS – ORDINANCE</u> Consider an ordinance to add that dogs in residentially zoned subdivisions that bark for more than ten consecutive minutes or for thirty non-consecutive minutes between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. are a violation of the Augusta County noise ordinance. The fine for violation of the ordinance will be \$100 for the first offense, \$250 for the second, and \$500 for the third such offense in a twelve-month period.
11-02	<u>PANHANDLING – ORDINANCE</u> Consider an ordinance that declares it unlawful to solicit money or other things of value in an aggressive manner in any public area, near banks and ATMs, on private property without permission of the property owner, and on, by, or adjacent to, any street or highway. The fine for violating the ordinance shall be not more than \$500.
11-03	<u>ALTERNATIVE ONSITE SEWAGE SYSTEMS – ORDINANCE</u> Consider an ordinance to allow for the installation, maintenance and operation of Alternative Onsite Sewage systems in Augusta County. This ordinance will conform to new requirements of the Code of Virginia and regulations promulgated by the Virginia Health Department.
11-04	<u>FIRE FLOW – ORDINANCE</u> Consider an ordinance to amend Section 24-2, Water Supply for Fire Protection, of the County Code to clarify the ordinance for new major residential subdivisions.
