### Malfunctions / Failures

Emergency Service Personnel will report all malfunctions and failures involving radio equipment provided by the County of Augusta to the senior Communicator on Duty, the Assistant Emergency Communications Center Director or the Emergency Communications Center Director.

When reporting a radio malfunction or failure, Emergency Service Personnel will describe the type of problem (in detail), define the type of radio equipment used, frequency (if applicable), and provide the date and time of occurrence.

The Augusta County Emergency Communications Center will log the incident and make the appropriate notifications.

### Lost / Missing Stolen

Emergency Service Personnel will report all lost, stolen or missing radio equipment to the appropriate personnel within his or her organization and to Augusta ECC immediately.
