### Landing Zones

Upon receipt to launch aeromedical transportation to an on scene mission, the Augusta County Emergency Communications Center will provide the commanding officer with the closest landing zone (road intersection or landmark) that is recommended to land aeromedical transportation on the assigned operational frequency. The commanding officer will determine the location for the landing zone.

In the event a landing zone is required, Augusta ECC will:

- Obtain:
  - Event Type (description)
  - Patient Status Report
    - Number of patients
    - Age / Gender of patient
    - Chief Complaint or Mechanism of injury
    - Current Vitals to include GCS of the patient
    - Other
  - Location (Landmark / Rural Route)
  - EMS Agency (First Due) handling the incident
  - Contact Information
  - Contact Communication Frequency at scene
  - Special Needs
- Augusta ECC will provide the above information to the appropriate aeromedical communications center
- **<Dispatch>** the appropriate response assignment to set up a landing zone (Unless otherwise specified)

- On the assigned operational frequency, provide the requestor the ETA of the aeromedical transport unit.
