### Infectious Control Notification

**Dispatch:** In the event the Augusta County Emergency Communications Center is informed of an individual that might expose Emergency Service Personnel to an infectious disease, Augusta ECC will follow the Standard Operating Guideline for dispatch and responding appended with “universal precautions are required”.

**Contacting the Infection Control Officer:** In the event Augusta ECC is informed a Fire-Rescue agency was exposed to an infectious communicable disease, Augusta ECC will: <Notify> the Infection Control Officer or alternate for the dispatched Fire-Rescue agency.

If Augusta ECC is unable to establish contact with the Infection Control Officer and alternate, Augusta ECC will: <Notify> the Chief Officer for the agency.
