



Single family homes increased slightly in 2011 with seven more homes. The average value per home remained steady with only a \$209 increase. The average square footage also remained about the same, 2,029 square feet in 2011 compared to 2,025 square feet in 2010.

There was a decrease of 88 multi-family units from 2010. The average value per unit increased to \$64,063, \$4,791 more than in 2010. The average square footage decreased to 1,030 square feet per unit, 122 square feet less than in 2010.


Manufactured housing decreased in 2011 with 154 less units than in 2010. The average cost per unit also decreased to \$34,571 in 2011, \$4,041 less than in 2010.







PERCENTAGE OF CONSTRUCTION VALUE BY DISTRICT IN 2011
